

We did it! This year the senior class of I Can Fly Girls High School ranked number one on the Kenya Certificate of Secondary School Examination in our local Sub-County. We are proud of the girls for achieving such a milestone. We salute these trailblazers for their commitment to education and hard-work.

OVERVIEW

2021

\$172,512 EDUCATION

Educational programs and special services were provided for 1,221 children and youth from five counties in Kenya. Children ages O-18 years old who are affected by early marriage, female genital mutilation, child labor, sexual abuse, child pregnancy, HIV/AIDS, and low - income backgrounds participated in programs offered through I Can Fly High School, Pre-School, Rescue Center and Alumni outreach programs. 967 pupils participated in empowerment training sessions led by ICF Alumni. 203 primary and secondary school level students received tuition fees, housing, meals, uniforms, school supplies, science materials, mattresses, hygiene kits, books and basic medical care.





Educational compliances, enrichment activities, shipping costs, internet connections and communications were provided at each facility. 42 students were provided early childhood education

classes five days per week. 9 youth received college tuition and laptops through the ICF Scholars program.

\$136,057 DEVELOPMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE

Campus development projects were provided at I Can Fly High School, Pre-school and I Can Fly Rescue Center. Construction Phases four and five were completed at I Can Fly High School which included four classrooms, three administration offices and one science lab. The I Can Fly Pre-School was constructed, providing two classrooms, one office and two toilets. Electricity installation, land-leveling, water tanks, and water pipes were installed for water conservation. The I Can Fly Rescue Center Phase one construction of a Butterfly House dormitory started with land-leveling and brick layering. Building repairs and maintenance to existing structures were provided throughout the year.




\$91,051 TRANSPORTATION

A 46 - seater Isuzu school bus was purchased for I Can Fly High School. Transportation fees were provided for students traveling to and from school, field trips, court appearances and special events. Emergency vehicles were rented during rescue efforts to ensure the safety of trauma victims. Repairs and maintenance were provided for four I Can Fly High School vehicles. Car insurance was purchased for each vehicle.







\$39,467FOOD PROGRAM


The Food Program provided Butterfly Project recipients three meals per day throughout the year at I Can Fly High School and Rescue center. Water and firewood were provided to prepare hot meals on each campus. Nutritious meals consisting of vegetables, beans, maize, bread and fruits were provided.

\$46,249 OPERATING EXPENSES

Operating Expenses include international communications, staff payroll, travel, internet services, printing, postage, shipping, advertisement, insurance fees, meetings and hospitality.


TOTAL EXPENSES
