

# OVERVIEW

### \$182,784 EDUCATION

Educational programs and special services were provided for children and youth from eight counties in Kenya. Children ages O18 years old who are affected by early marriage, female genital mutilation, child labor, sexual abuse, teen pregnancy, HIV/AIDS, and low-income backgrounds participated in programs offered through I Can Fly High School, Pre-School, Rescue Center and Alumni outreach programs. received tuition fees, housing, meals, uniforms, school supplies, mattresses, hygiene kits, medical care, books and school supplies. We also provided support in the form of educational compliances, legal fees, travel expenses,


enrichment activities, field trips and workshops. The Scholars program recipients received tuition fees and stipends to attend various Universities, colleges and trade schools throughout Kenya.



### \$50,519

#### **DEVELOPMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE**

Development and Infrastructure projects were provided at I Can Fly High School with Phase One construction of a new dormitory called the Big Butterfly House. The new structure is a tri-level building located on the south end of campus for incoming freshman students due to spacing issues in other living facilities on campus. The Preschool campus added walk-ways, fencing and landscaping for beautification purposes. Various buildings and outdoor areas were updated with fresh paint and new piping systems.





# \$68,453 TRANSPORTATION

A four-wheel drive, seven-seater vehicle was purchased for transportation needs throughout the school year during rough-road travel to and from school, meetings and school emergencies. All school vehicles were provided fuel, repairs, regular maintenance and road safety compliance fees. Five vehicles were fully insured throughout the school year. Students received transportation fees via chartered buses, private vehicles and school bus outings for academic contests and enrichment activities.





# **\$38,361** FOOD PROGRAM

The Food Program provided Butterfly Project recipients three meals per day throughout the year at I Can Fly High School and Rescue center. Water and firewood were provided to prepare hot meals on each campus. Nutritious meals consisting of vegetables, beans, maize, bread and fruits were provided.



# \$76,673 OPERATING EXPENSES


Traveling expenses were provided for global travel, accommodation, meetings, internet services, communications, staffing costs, postage, printing, mailing services, office supplies, marketing, advertisement, contractor fees and outreach activities. Compliances, insurance, bank fees, and trainings were conducted on a regular basis.


